3. Suffering is simply a part of everyone’s life here on this side of eternity. No one gets out of this life alive, and no one gets through this life without suffering. Just ask Jesus. What stands between Jesus’ transfiguration and His resurrection on Easter morning?

As the Christian Church prepares to enter another Lenten Season on Ash Wednesday, what are some preparations that need to be made in your life? What are some things or situations in your circles that make for a bumpy flight? What are Jesus’ promises to you concerning these?
